3 **Resolution appointing Peter Fatooh and Carol Ruth Silver to the Assessment Appeals**
4 **Board No. 1 for a three-year term ending September 3, 2007.**

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
6 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the
7 Assessment Appeals Board #1, pursuant to the provisions of the Revenue and Taxation
8 Code, Section 1623, and the San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 2B.1 through 2B.11,
9 for the term specified:

10 Peter Fatooh, succeeding himself, term expiring September 6, 2004, seat 1, must meet
11 the eligibility criteria set forth in Section 1624.05 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code
12 as follows: Must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of
13 California as one of the following: Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or Public Accountant
14 (PA); licensed Real Estate Broker; Attorney; or a Property Appraiser accredited by a nationally
15 recognized professional organization, or Property Appraiser certified by the Office of Real
16 Estate Appraisers; or he or she is a current member of an assessment appeals board, for a
17 three-year term ending September 3, 2007.

18 Carol Ruth Silver, succeeding Thomas Ramm, term expiring September 6, 2004, seat
19 4, must meet the eligibility criteria set forth in Section 1624.05 of the California Revenue and
20 Taxation Code as follows: Must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the
21 State of California as one of the following: Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or Public
22 Accountant (PA); licensed Real Estate Broker; Attorney; or a Property Appraiser accredited by
23 a nationally recognized professional organization, or Property Appraiser certified by the Office
24 of Real Estate Appraisers; or he or she is a current member of an assessment appeals board
25 for a three-year term ending September 3, 2007.
