WHEREAS, Mr. Hormel's employment qualifications include service as an Alternate Representative of the U.S. Delegation to the 51st Session of the United Nations Human Rights Commission; and,

WHEREAS, James Hormel has proven himself to be a magnanimous philanthropist for the City and County of San Francisco, providing and promoting education, health, art, and culture for all San Franciscans; and,

WHEREAS, On June 4, 1999, President Clinton bypassed the Senate and appointed James Hormel as ambassador to Luxembourg; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends James Hormel upon his appointment to the post of Ambassador to Luxembourg; and, be it
