3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type-64 special on-sale general**  
4 **theater liquor license to the Exit Theatre, located at 156 Eddy Street (District 6),**  
5 **will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San**  
6 **Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,**  
7 **Section 23958.4; and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic**  
8 **Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.**

10 WHEREAS, The Exit Theatre is seeking the issuance of a Type-64 special on-  
11 sale general theater liquor license to the Exit Theatre, located at 156 Eddy Street  
12 (District 6); and

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly  
14 zoned and recommends approval; and

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests and zero (0)  
16 letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California  
17 Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department  
18 of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the  
20 following: 1) all sales of alcoholic beverages in the general spectator seating areas  
21 shall be made only from concession stands and shall not be sold, served, or delivered  
22 to customers by individual ambulatory vendors, more commonly known as "hawkers;" 2)  
23 point of sale of alcoholic beverages shall not be maintained within the theater  
24 auditoriums; 3) no more than two (2) alcoholic beverages shall be sold or served to any  
25 one (1) person during any transaction; 4) the sale of alcoholic beverages for off-sale

1 consumption is strictly prohibited; 5) alcoholic beverages shall be served in containers  
2 which significantly differ in appearance from those containers utilized for non-alcoholic  
3 beverages; containers for beer shall not exceed 16 ounces; this condition does not  
4 preclude the service of alcoholic beverages in the original containers; 6) at all times  
5 when the premises are exercising the privileges of their licenses, an employee of the  
6 premises shall enter and monitor the activity within the theater on a regular basis, but  
7 not less than ever 30 minutes; 7) loitering (loitering shall be defined as "to stand idly  
8 about; linger without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property  
9 adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the  
10 ABC-257 dated June 27, 2017; 8) no noise shall be audible at any nearby residence or  
11 the four (4) consideration points; 9) notwithstanding any other conditions no. 4 and no. 5  
12 on this petition, alcoholic beverages may be sold or served by waiters or waitresses in  
13 the general spectator seating areas under the following conditions: a) only persons  
14 occupying seats in the theater auditoriums shall be permitted to order and be served  
15 alcoholic beverages; b) orders from patrons seated in the theater auditoriums must be  
16 made to the waiter or waitress serving that area and the alcoholic beverages must be  
17 personally delivered to the patron by the waiter or waitress who took the order; c) the  
18 waiter or waitress serving in the theater auditoriums shall not carry a supply of  
19 unordered alcoholic beverages; now, therefore, be it

20           RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,  
21 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 hereby determines that the issuance of a Type-64 special on-sale general theater liquor  
23 license to the Exit Theatre, located at 156 Eddy Street (District 6), will serve the public

7. Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 6/27/17.
8. No noise shall be audible at any nearby residence or the four (4) consideration points.

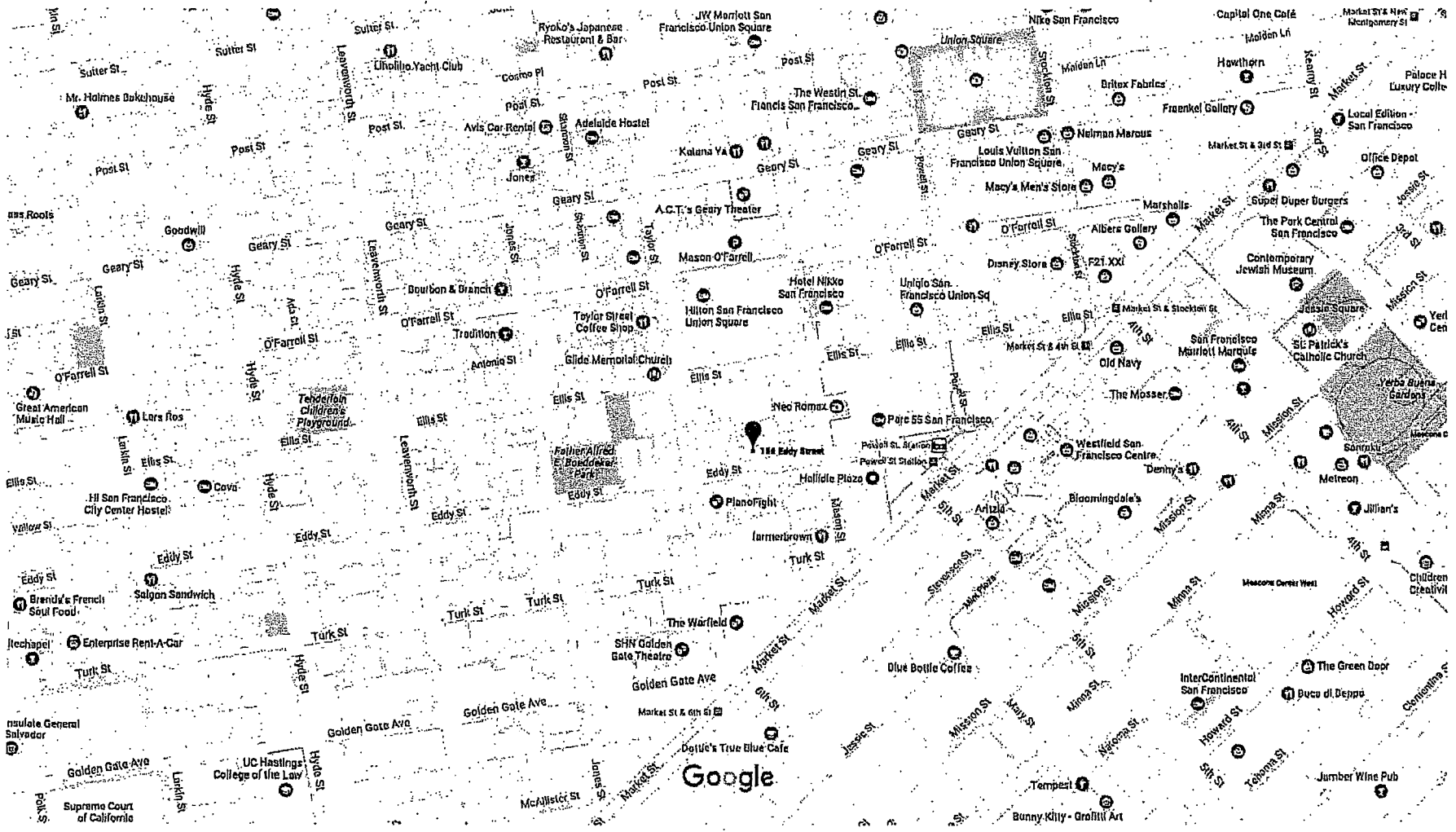


9. Notwithstanding any other condition(s) #4 & #5 on this petition, alcoholic beverages may be sold or served by waiters or waitresses in the general spectator seating areas under the following conditions:
- a. Only persons occupying seats in the theater auditoriums shall be permitted to order and be served alcoholic beverages.
  - b. Orders from patrons seated in the theater auditoriums must be made to the waiter or waitress serving that area and the alcoholic beverages must be personally delivered to the patron by the waiter or waitress who took the order.
  - c. The waiter or waitress serving in the theater auditoriums shall not carry a supply of unordered alcoholic beverages.

❖ It should be noted that the Applicant agrees with all the above conditions.

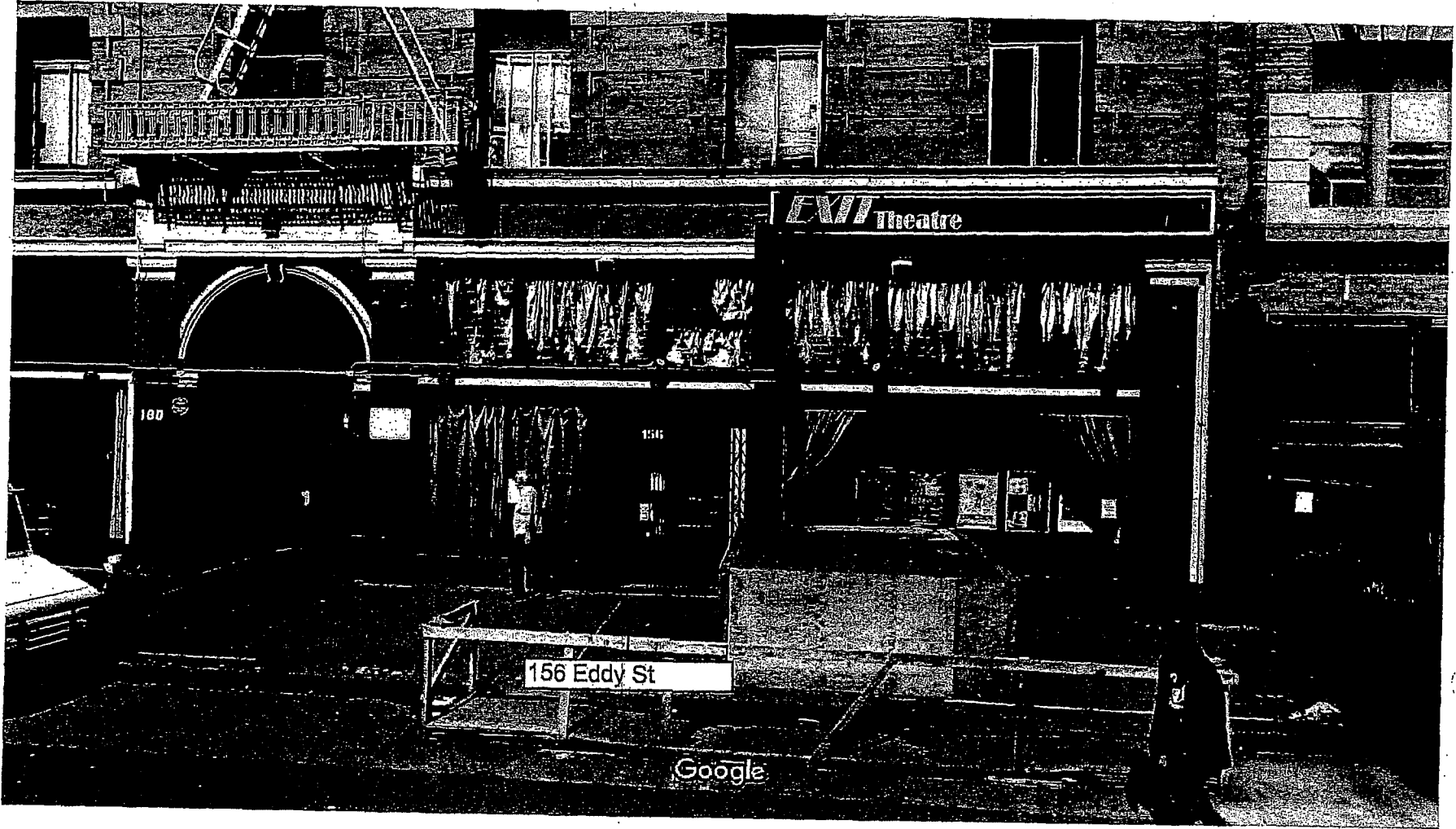

EXIT Theatre is writing to request support for our application with the California Alcoholic Beverage Control for a Type 64 Special On-Sale General Theatre license for our theater at 156 Eddy Street.

EXIT Theatre is a 34-year-old award winning nonprofit Tenderloin theater, founded in 1983, that presents 500 performances each year by a large number of ethnic, gender, and age diverse theater artists. Since 1994 we have been serving food and beverages, including beer and wine, to our patrons without incident under our existing Type 41 On Sale Beer & Wine license. We are now seeking to replace our existing Type 41 license with a Type 64 Special On-Sale General Theatre license.

The sale of alcoholic beverages would only be available to audiences at our theatrical performances starting no earlier than two hours before the performance and ending no later than one hour after the performance. Food and beverages are a small part of our theatrical operation but the concessions provide an important and expected amenity to our patrons. Whether it be large cultural institutions like the opera or the American Conservatory Theatre, or smaller community theatres, concessions, including alcohol in moderation, are expected. The Type 64 license would allow EXIT Theatre to come more in line with the rest of the theaters in our community.

We respectfully request that the Board of Supervisors make a finding that issuance of a Type 64 license at this location will serve public convenience or necessity.
