

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Zellerbach Family Foundation - \$37,000]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Adult Probation Department to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant of consulting services from the Zellerbach Family Foundation through an**
5 **award to Community Works West in the amount of \$37,000 for developing a gender-**
6 **responsive approach to serving women involved in San Francisco's criminal justice**
7 **system.**

9 WHEREAS, The Zellerbach Family Foundation awarded a grant of consulting services
10 to the Adult Probation Department on December 7, 2011 on the development of a gender-
11 responsive approach to serving women involved in San Francisco's criminal justice system
12 based on a grant proposal submitted by Adult Probation Department; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to a grant agreement entered into by Zellerbach Family
14 Foundation, Adult Probation Department, and Community Works West; Zellerbach Family
15 Foundation transmitted \$37,000 in grant funding to Community Works West to contract with
16 consultants to provide the consulting services as the fiscal sponsor for this project; and

17 WHEREAS, Community Works West has contracted with consultants Barbara Bloom,
18 Ph.D. and Barbara Owen, Ph.D., to develop a system of case management and other services
19 which are appropriate to the needs of women involved in San Francisco's criminal justice
20 system, and will also perform report writing functions that are a condition of the grant funding;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, Addressing women's pathways to offending and structuring a safe and
23 appropriate rehabilitative environment are critical to reducing recidivism and improving post-
24 release outcomes for women offenders; and

25 WHEREAS, To make a significant impact on San Francisco's female offenders, the
Adult Probation Department should develop innovative and focused interventions that

1 address the differences between men and women and target the specific risks and needs of
2 criminal justice-involved women; and

3 WHEREAS, The City would benefit from the development of gender-responsive
4 services in order to improve local outcomes for criminal justice-involved women; and

5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

6 WHEREAS, The grant does not include any funding for indirect costs of the City in the
7 grant budget, and no funding will be received by City in acceptance of this grant of services
8 and; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the Adult Probation Department is hereby authorized to retroactively
10 accept a grant of services, through Community Works West as a fiscal sponsor for grant
11 funds, in the amount of \$37,000 from the Zellerbach Family Foundation for the purpose of
12 developing a gender-responsive approach to serving women involved in San Francisco's
13 criminal justice system; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of an
15 indirect cost allocation for the City and County of San Francisco in the grant budget.




