3 **Resolution approving the 2006/07 Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Program; and**
4 **authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to apply for,**
5 **accept, and expend the City's 2006/07 Emergency Shelter Grant entitlement from the**
6 **U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amount of \$928,391;**
7 **and approving the expenditure schedule for recipient agencies..**

9 WHEREAS, Under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and Cranston
10 Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of
11 Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is authorized to make a grant to the City and County
12 of San Francisco under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program (ESG); and,

13 WHEREAS, WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco anticipates receiving
14 \$928,391 in 2006/07 ESG Program funds; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Citizen's Committee on Community Development (CCCD) has
16 reviewed applications and prepared recommendations for the use of the anticipated \$928,391
17 ESG grant for fiscal year 2006/07, a copy of which is located in Board File No. 060413
18 (the "Expenditure Schedule"); and,

19 WHEREAS, As set forth in the Expenditure Schedule, the ESG Program funds will be
20 used to provide for the rehabilitation or conversion of buildings for use as emergency shelters
21 for the homeless, for the payment of certain operating and social service expenses in
22 connection with emergency shelters, and for homeless prevention; and,

23 WHEREAS, An Environmental Review Record has been prepared by the Mayor's
24 Office of Community Development (MOCD) and approved by the Certifying Officer for the
25 proposed projects and activities as described in the Expenditure Schedule in accordance with

1 the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and other applicable statutes and authorities, in
2 particular those cited in 24 CFR Part 58 §§5 and 6, a copy of which is located in Board File
3 No. 060413; and,

4 WHEREAS, the Certifying Officer shall follow the procedural provisions of NEPA to
5 confirm that all projects funded under the CDBG Program are in compliance with applicable
6 federal regulations and requirements; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby
8 authorized to apply for, accept, and expend the City's 2006 ESG Program entitlement from
9 HUD in accordance with the Expenditure Schedule; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the
11 Expenditure Schedule for recipient agencies; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute
13 agreements between the City and County of San Francisco and agencies identified in the
14 Expenditure Schedule; and, be it



15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation

20 with respect to the application for, or the acceptance or expenditure of, 2006/07 ESG funds
21 are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.




