14 WHEREAS, Funds are available for recreational trail projects,
15 through the Recreational Trail Program administered by the State of
16 California Department of Parks and Recreations; and

17 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department
18 requests approval to apply for grant funds from the California State
19 Department of Parks and Recreation to rehabilitate the Twin Peaks
20 Trail; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the
22 Recreation and Park Department to apply for grant funds from this
23 program for the rehabilitation of the Twin Peaks Trail.
