3	Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to apply for a grant in the
4	amount of \$261,961 from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for
5	enforcing proper disposal of waste tires.
6	
7	WHEREAS, Senate Bill 876 requires the California Integrated Waste Management
8	Board to consider designating a city or county, or city and county as the enforcement authority
9	of regulations relating to the storage and handling of waste and used tires; and,
10	WHEREAS, Senate Bill 876 also requires that if the Board designates a local entity for
11	this purpose, it provides sufficient, stable, and non-competitive funding; and,
12	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will enter into agreement with the
13	State of California for implementation of a waste tire enforcement program; and,
14	WHEREAS, The grant is a non-competitive grant that is available to the City and
15	County of San Francisco from the California Integrated Waste Management Board; and
16	WHEREAS, The grant application includes administrative overhead costs of \$23,815 in
17	the grant budget; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of
19	the Department of the Environment to apply for funding of \$261,961 from the California
20	Integrated Waste Management Board for a Waste Tire Enforcement Grant. The Director of
21	the Department of the Environment, or their designee, is hereby authorized and empowered
22	to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all necessary applications,
23	contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments hereto for the purposes of
24	securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant
25	application.
