MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into as of August 13, 2009, by and between the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") through its First Source Hiring Administration ("FSHA") and Lowes HIW, Inc. ("Project Sponsor").

WHEREAS, Project Sponsor, as developer, proposes to construct 107,400 square feet of commercial space (the "Project") at 491 Bayshore Avenue/196 Loomis Street, Lots 8, 9, 11,13, 15,16, 18, 21 and 28 in Assessor's Block 5598, San Francisco California ("Site"); and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Code of the City provides at Chapter 83 for a "First Source Hiring Program" which has as its purpose the creation of employment opportunities for qualified Economically Disadvantaged Individuals (as defined in Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the Project requires a building permit for a commercial activity of greater than 25,000 square feet and/or is a residential project greater than ten (10) units and therefore falls within the scope of the Chapter 83 of the Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the City and Project Sponsor agree that the City of San Francisco's Office of Economic and Workforce Development ("OEWD") and the CityBuild program ("CityBuild") will serve the roles set forth below; and

WHEREAS, Project Sponsor has not yet entered into a contract with a construction contractor ("Contractor") to construct the Project upon the Site, nor has the identity of the Contractor been determined; and

WHEREAS, Project Sponsor wishes to make a good faith effort to comply with the City's First Source Hiring Program.

Therefore, the parties to this Memorandum of Understanding agree as follows:

A. Project Sponsor, upon entering into a contract for the construction of the Project after the date of this MOU, will include in that contract a provision requiring the Contractor to execute a First Source Hiring Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and the Form 1 City Build Workforce Projection Form attached hereto as Exhibit B. It is the Project Sponsor's responsibility to provide a signed copy of Exhibit A to First Source Hiring Program and CityBuild.
