

- 4) Premises-to-Premises Transfer of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control Type 51 (Club) license for the prior location of Treasure Island Yacht Club.
- 5) When full operation resumes Treasure Island Yacht Club will be open on weekends between the hours of 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. It is *occasionally* open at other times on an *ad ho*c basis.
- 6) Filing of the application was completed in person at the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control offices at 33 New Montgomery Street, San Francisco, California on August 19, 2021;
- 7) The notice was posted on August 31, 2021; to the knowledge of TIYC no objection has been made to the transfer to date. Treasure Island Yacht Club was established in 1966. Although it primarily served the military community based on Treasure Island initially but particularly since decommissioning of the Naval Station and transfer of possession of Treasure Island to the City and County of San Francisco, it has been involved with the local sailing community in a variety of ways, including sponsoring sailing races and regattas and hosting sail-ins of various members of the Pacific Inter-Club Yacht Association. We also conduct training sessions including boating safety and offering courtesy boat inspections. As Treasure Island development continues we anticipate becoming an important recreational outlet for Island residents as well as the citizens of San Francisco. Social events are a critical element of the club's revenue stream and it is important that transfer of the license be approved at the earliest possible moment so that the club can resume hosting these important events.

It is important to note that Treasure Island Yacht Club has always been in proximity to the marina (independently operated) and that the current relocation is less than 500 yards from its prior location at 300 Clipper Cove Way. Also, Treasure Island Yacht Club was first licensed in 2002. In all the time since then there has never been any incident of misbehavior resulting from the service of alcohol at the club nor has Treasure Island Yacht Club ever been cited for any violation of the ABC's rules of regulations.
