Resolution adding the commemorative street name "Polytechnic Way" to the 700 block of Frederick Street in recognition of San Francisco's first public high school and its contribution to the education of thousands of San Franciscans from 1894 to 1972.

WHEREAS, Polytechnic High School (Poly) was the first public high school in San Francisco, California from 1884 until 1973; and

WHEREAS, Polytechnic High School was located with entrances at 701 Frederick Street and exits at 372 Carl Street, and was bordered by Willard and Arguello Streets in San Francisco, California; and

WHEREAS, Kezar Stadium was originally a part of Poly's athletic facilities, and over 50,000 people attended Poly's football games against Lowell High School in both 1928 and 1947; and

WHEREAS, Polytechnic High School notable alumni includes former 49ers head coach George Seifert, former Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger, pro footballer Bob St. Clair, musician Paul Desmond, actress Janet Gaynor, lead singer Victor Willis of Village People, Nobel Prize in Physics recipient Luis Walter Alvarez, artist Louis Macouillard, cartoonist Tad Dorgan, physicist Edward Ginzton, athlete Alice Marble – International Tennis Hall of Fame, musician Merl Saunders, announcer George Fenneman, and Rudy Rintala, a four-sport star athlete at Stanford University during the 1930's; and

WHEREAS, Thousands of Polytechnic High School graduates went on to live and work in the San Francisco Bay Area, collectively making a positive difference throughout the years; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in order to celebrate the legacy and contributions of Polytechnic High School, the San Francisco Public Works is directed to add the honorary street name to its official list of Commemorative Street Names in accordance with 17 Public Works Code, Section 789 et seq.
