Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community Behavioral Health Services (DPH-CBHS) to enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement with the State of California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (DADP) for the term of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013, in the amount of \$60,402,780 and for the term of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, in the amount of \$20,134,260 as a condition of receiving state funds and Drug Medi-Cal reimbursement for substance abuse treatment and prevention; holding DADP harmless from any and all claims resulting from the agreement; authorizing and designating the DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator to sign said Agreement and to approve amendments for less than 10% of the contracted amount.

[State Contract Funds for Substance Abuse Treatment - \$60,402,780]

WHEREAS, Approval of the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and the Drug Medi-Cal Agreement between DADP and DPH-CBHS would (1) enable the City to accept the State DADP's FY 2010-11 funding allocation, or NNA, for the provision of substance abuse services in San Francisco, and (2) authorize the State DADP to encumber Drug Medi-Cal funds for the purpose of reimbursing the City for Drug Medi-Cal services provided by Community Behavioral Health Services's (CBHS's) service providers in FY 2010-11, for a combined total amount of \$20,134,260; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement includes a hold harmless clause which provides that the City will hold the State harmless from (1) any claims and losses resulting to contractors, subcontractors, individuals, firms and corporations furnishing or supplying work services, materials, or supplies in connection to the performance of this contract and (2) any claims and

losses resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged in connection to the City's performance of this contract; and

WHEREAS, The DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator is designated to sign the Combined Net Amount and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement and approve future amendments for less than ten percent (10%) of the contracted amount; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH-CBHS is hereby authorized to enter into a Combined Negotiated Net Agreement and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement with DADP for the term of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$60,402,780 and for the term of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 in the amount of \$20,134,260 as a condition of receiving State funds and Drug Medi-Cal reimbursement for substance abuse treatment and prevention; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Agreement shall include an indemnification of the ; and, be it State of California as set forth in File No. 101109

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

# **Legislative Objective**

The proposed resolution would authorize the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), Community Behavioral Health Services to enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement with the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs for a three-year term from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013 in the total amount of \$60,402,780.

### **Key Points**

Under State law, San Francisco is reimbursed by the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs for the County's costs associated with providing various substance abuse services. In order to receive this reimbursement, the City must enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement with the State.

Approval of the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement between the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs and the County of San Francisco (1) enables the County to accept the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs' funding allocation for substance abuse services, and (2) authorizes the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs to encumber Federal Drug/Medi-Cal funds to reimburse the County for services provided by DPH Community Behavioral Health Services to eligible individuals.

The substance abuse services that would be funded by the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement were included in the FY 2010-11 DPH budget as previously approved by the Board of Supervisors.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The proposed Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement would provide \$20,134,260 per year to the County, totaling \$60,402,780 for three years. Because the State has not yet adopted its FY 2010-11 budget, the proposed Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement may be amended to reflect reduced State General Funds. According to Ms. Ann Santos, Community Behavioral Health Services Epidemiologist, any reduction in State funds would result in a corresponding reduction in substance abuse services.

#### Recommendations

- Amend the proposed resolution to retroactively approve the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement.
- Approve the proposed resolution.

# **BACKGROUND/MANDATE STATEMENT**

### **Background**

Under State law, San Francisco is reimbursed by the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs for the County's costs associated with providing various substance abuse services. In order to receive this reimbursement, the City must enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement with the State.

The DPH Community Behavioral Health Services currently funds approximately 100 different substance abuse treatment and prevention programs provided by 45 community based organizations. Counties negotiate with the State to determine rates for different types of substance abuse services, and these rates are then incorporated into an agreement between the State and the County.

The agreement between the State and the County is a combined agreement that includes:

- The Net Negotiated Amount, which are California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs funds (State General Fund) and Federal block grant funds provided to the County for substance abuse services.
- The Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement, which are Medi-Cal reimbursements to the County for substance abuse services provided to eligible recipients.

The proposed resolution would approve the Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement of \$60,402,780 for FY 2010-11 through FY 2012-13, or \$20,134,260 per year for three years.

### **Mandate Statement**

Charter Section 9.118(c) requires the Board of Supervisors to approve contracts that exceed \$10 million or ten years.

# DETAILS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Approval of the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement between the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs and the County of San Francisco (1) enables the County to accept the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs' funding allocation for substance abuse services, and (2) authorizes the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs to encumber Federal Drug/Medi-Cal funds to reimburse the County for services provided by DPH Community Behavioral Health Services.

The substance abuse services that would be funded by the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement were included in the FY 2010-11 DPH budget, as previously approved by the Board of Supervisors.

Because the proposed Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement is for a three-year term, which begins on July 1, 2010, the proposed resolution should be amended to retroactively approve the Agreement.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

The proposed Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement would provide \$20,134,260 per year to the County, totaling \$60,402,780 for three years. The table below shows the allocation of Federal and State funds by fiscal year.

Because the State has not yet adopted its FY 2010-11 budget, the proposed Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement may be amended to reflect reduced State General Funds. No less than 60 days after the State adopts the FY 2010-11 budget, the State will notify the County of the final allocation to the DPH Community Behavioral Health Services.

The actual Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement funds allocated to the County in FY 2010-11 through FY 2012-13 could be less than \$20,134,260 per year, or \$60,402,780 for three years, if the adopted State budget allocates fewer State General Funds to the County. As noted in the table above, the FY 2010-11 proposed State General Fund allocation to the County is \$5,055,975, or approximately 25.1 percent of the total allocation of \$20,134,260. According to Ms. Ann Santos, Community Behavioral Health Services Epidemiologist, any reduction in State funds would result in a corresponding reduction in substance abuse services.

# RECOMMENDATIONS

- Amend the proposed resolution to retroactively approve the Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug/Medi-Cal Agreement.
- Approve the proposed resolution as amended.

# State Combined Negotiated Net Amount and Drug Medi-Cal Hold Harmless Agreement

#### **SUMMARY**

Approval of the Combined Negotiated Net Amount (NNA) and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement between the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (DADP) and the City and County of San Francisco (1) enables the City to accept the State DADP's funding allocation, or NNA, for the provision of substance abuse services in San Francisco, and (2) authorizes the State DADP to encumber federal Drug-Medi-Cal funds for the purpose of reimbursing the City for Drug-Medi-Cal services provided by Community Behavioral Health Service's (CBHS) service providers. The Agreement is the regular mechanism that the State uses to provide California counties the annual state appropriation of alcohol and drug funds, to pass through to the counties the Federal block grant appropriations for substance abuse, and to provide a reimbursement mechanism for approved Drug Medi-Cal claims.

The term of the Agreement is July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013. The State maintains a three year contracting cycle, with the next cycle starting as of July 1, 2010. The contract will contain three years of annual funding. Therefore, the next Agreement will have the term of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016 and contain funding for the period starting July 1, 2013.

The funding contained in the contract is subject to amendment after the State passes or amends its annual budget. The agreement amount for FY 2010-2011 is \$20,134,260. The agreement does not contain service detail. No less than sixty (60) days after the State establishes a 2010-2011 budget, the State will forward a final allocation to CBHS with instructions for creating a service budget. The services and expenditures funded through this agreement consist entirely of those included in the Department's 2010-2011 budget, now pending approval by the Board of Supervisors.

The Agreement includes the State's standard, mandatory hold harmless clause, which provides that the City will hold the State harmless for (1) any claims and losses resulting to contractors, subcontractors, individuals, firms and corporations furnishing or supplying work services, materials or supplies in connection to performance of this contract and (2) any claims and losses resulting to any person, firm or corporation who may be injured or damaged in connection by the City's performance of this contract.
