[Agreement - AT&T Corporation - Telecommunication Services - Not to Exceed \$80,000,000]

Resolution authorizing the Department of Technology to enter into an agreement with AT&T Corporation to purchase wired voice and data network and telecommunication services, with a not to exceed amount of \$80,000,000 for a six and one-half year term of January 1, 2022, through June 30, 2028, and with one five-year option to extend, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118.

WHEREAS, Since 2001, the Department of Technology ("Department") has been procuring telecommunications services for the City and County of San Francisco ("City") from AT&T Corporation ("AT&T") under a series of contracts that were approved by the Board of Supervisors; those contracts have all incorporated the terms and conditions of the State of California's Integrated Telecommunications Network agreements ("CALNET contracts"); and

WHEREAS, The City's existing agreement with AT&T to purchase those services was entered into in 2010 after approval from the Board of Supervisors; that agreement, which was amended five times with Board of Supervisors approval, will expire on December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The State of California has entered into a new set of CALNET contracts with AT&T that are known as the CALNET-Next Generation contracts; and

WHEREAS, Under the CALNET-Next Generation contracts, State agencies and local governments are able to purchase modern wired voice and data network services from AT&T at the lowest rates; the State's procurement process and buying power ensures that the best pricing is available to public entities; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 21.16(b), the City may utilize the results of a competitive solicitation by another public agency; and

WHEREAS, The Department has negotiated a new agreement with AT&T that would allow City departments to purchase these telecommunications services using the pricing and other terms and conditions contained in the CALNET-Next Generation contracts ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, The initial term of the Agreement is for six and a half years, but under the Agreement DT has an option to extend the term of an additional five years, with Board of Supervisors approval, unless the State terminates the CALNET-Next Generation contracts before that date; and

WHEREAS, A number of City departments are presently purchasing certain legacy telecommunications services from AT&T that are not available under the CALNET-Next Generation contracts; and

WHEREAS, DT has determined that AT&T is a sole source for these legacy services; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Administration has approved the waiver of the competitive solicitation requirements for these legacy services; and

WHEREAS, The Department has evaluated the wired voice and data network and telecommunication services needs of City departments from January 1, 2022, through June 30, 2028; the Department has determined that the City's spending under the Agreement during its six and one-half year term will be \$80,000,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the Charter requires approval by the Board of Supervisors for contracts in excess of ten years or requiring expenditures above \$10,000,000; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Agreement between the City and AT&T to allow City departments to purchase wired voice and data network and telecommunication services for a term of six and one-half years beginning on January 1, 2022, with a not to exceed amount of \$80,000,000; a copy of the Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 211089; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully executed by the parties the Department of Technology shall provide it to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
