

1 [Contract Amendment - Retroactive - Helios Healthcare, LLC - Behavioral Health Services -  
2 Not to Exceed \$27,904,325]

3 **Resolution retroactively approving Amendment No. 2 to the agreement between Helios**  
4 **Healthcare, LLC and the Department of Public Health (DPH), for behavioral health**  
5 **services, to increase the agreement by \$18,239,925 for an amount not to exceed**  
6 **\$27,904,325; to extend the term by six years and six months, from December 31, 2021,**  
7 **through June 30, 2028, for a total agreement term of July 1, 2018, through June 30,**  
8 **2028; and to authorize DPH to enter into amendments or modifications to the contract**  
9 **prior to its final execution by all parties that do not materially increase the obligations**  
10 **or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the contract.**

12 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (DPH) selected Helios Healthcare, LLC  
13 in November 2017 through a Request for Proposals to provide psychiatric care to adults  
14 and/or older adults in a Locked Licensed Facility, Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) and/or Mental  
15 Health Rehabilitation Center (MHRC); and

16 WHEREAS, DPH entered into an agreement with Helios Healthcare, LLC to provide  
17 these services for three years, July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2021, for an amount not to  
18 exceed \$8,400,000 and subsequently amending the agreement to extend the contract term  
19 through December 31, 2021, and to increase the agreement by \$1,264,400 for an amount not  
20 to exceed \$9,664,400; and

21 WHEREAS, Under this agreement, Helios Healthcare, LLC provides long-term care  
22 services in a locked facility at its Idylwood Care Center to San Francisco residents with  
23 medical problems and/or physical impairments requiring special needs, including those that  
24 may require the use of wheelchairs, walkers or canes, and they may also have vision and/or

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1 hearing loss or speech impairments, presenting a combination of medical and behavioral  
2 issues, and who may have dementia as a primary diagnosis; and

3 WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Charter requires approval of the Board  
4 of Supervisors for contracts requiring anticipated expenditures exceeding \$10 million; now,  
5 therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public  
7 Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the  
8 City and County of San Francisco, to execute Amendment No. 2 to the agreement with Helios  
9 Healthcare, LLC for behavioral health services for an amount not to exceed \$27,904,325 and  
10 a total agreement term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2028; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of  
12 Public Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to the contract, prior to its final  
13 execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in consultation with the City  
14 Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not otherwise materially increase the  
15 obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of  
16 the contract, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract being fully executed  
18 by all parties, the Director of Health and/or the Director of the Office of Contract  
19 Administration/Purchaser shall provide the final contracts to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion  
20 into the official File No. 211165.
