

3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Dacari Spiers against the City
4	and County of San Francisco for \$700,000; the lawsuit was filed on March 6, 2020, in
5	United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 20-cv-01357-JSC;
6	entitled <u>Dacari Spiers v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.</u> ; the lawsuit involves
7	an alleged civil rights violation.

9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
11	authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Dacari Spiers v. City and County of
12	San Francisco, et al., United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case
13	No. 20-cv-01357-JSC by the payment of \$700,000. The lawsuit involves an alleged civil rights
14	violation occurring on October 6, 2019.
