COVID-19

4,922 rapid tests were administered on Sunday, January 2 - Sunday January 9

2,200

home kits were distributed January 2-3 and January 7 9,977

Color self swab testing have been processed from January 3 - 9



46,000+

Color test kits were delivered to sites last week; more tests are being delivered this week.

56,000

test kits from the State arrived last week and are being distributed to sites.

Current Guidance on Masking for Schools

For this Guidance

- face masks includes cloth face coverings that cover the mouth and nose
- face masks must not have an exhalation valve

Face masks are required indoors for everyone 24 months and older, even if they have been fully vaccinated for COVID-19 with the exemption noted for specific sports and extracurricular activities



About Masks

- A well-fitted mask that can be comfortably worn is most important.
- Double masking is an effective way to improve fit and filtration.
- A close-fitting cloth mask can be worn on top of a surgical/disposable mask to improve the seal of the mask to the face.
