Thank you for your email. Below is the additional written explanation regarding the “retroactive” approval we shared with the Budget & Finance Committee, please forward this same information for file 211239 to Members of the Full Board of Supervisors. Andrew Abou Jaoude, OEWD's Workforce Hospitality Initiative Manager, will be available to answer questions from Members of the Board if they arise on 1/25/22.

Retroactive Nature of Resolution

File 211239 is a Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of Economic and Workforce Development to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$500,000 from the North Valley Workforce Development Board, a recipient of the grant award from United States Department of Labor for CAREER National Dislocated Worker Grant during the grant period of October 1, 2021 through August 19, 2023.

The United States Department of Labor released emergency Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) National Dislocated Worker Grants to support the workforce in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and nationwide shelter-in-place order. The United States Department of Labor awarded The North Valley Workforce Development Board, as lead applicant for the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit, CAREER National Dislocated Worker Grant to support dislocated workers; and as pass-through the United States Department of Labor awarded the Office of Economic and Workforce Development \$500,000 of federal WIOA funds to support dislocated workers following the close of the OEWD's budget period for FY 21-22.

Program Description

- **Equitable Outreach** - Focused outreach to disadvantaged/opportunity neighborhoods and SFO: Self-Help for the Elderly (SHE) will focus on the Chinatown, Tenderloin, and SOMA areas. Mission Hiring Hall (MHH) will focus outreach efforts to Mission, Bayview/Hunter's Point, Western Addition, and Visitation Valley/Sunnydale areas. All areas of focus are SF Districts with high unemployment rates and have a high number of minorities who have historically been underserved (see census data we sent 7/7). SFO outreach will be shared by both agencies, with OEWD being liaison, connector, and provides over cite.
- **General Reemployment Services:** All participants will receive reemployment services

that are offered in a virtual and/or in-person environment and include: career assessment, career advising, one-on-one job search support; resume review; interview preparation; development of an individualized employment plan; job coaching; access to computer and utilities. OEWD will provide supportive services such as transportation, clothing, child care, linkage to community or social services, and other supportive services defined by WIOA. Supportive services for each participant will be up to \$300 per participant (\$30,000 total).

- **Direct Placement Services** - Employment: Upon completion of General Reemployment Services and career assessment, participants will be intensely supported to find employment through Direct Placement services. Both SHE and MHH have connections to a myriad of job opportunities within San Francisco's growth sector industries, which include information and community technology, health care, hospitality and construction. OEWD staff will provide over site, as well as connection to employer partners.
