10 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after

11 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

12 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board

13 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

15 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors

16 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,

17 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal

18 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment

19 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under

20 the official title of the ordinance.
