[Application for Grant - Augmenting the Greening and Stormwater Features of the Cesar Chavez Street Redesign Project]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Planning Department to apply for a grant from the State of California Sustainable Communities Planning Grant and Incentives Program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) to augment the greening and stormwater features of the Cesar Chavez Street redesign project.

WHEREAS, The Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above; and
