3	Resolution extending by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Historic
4	Preservation Commission may render its decision on a proposed Resolution (File No.
5	210426) initiating a landmark designation under Article 10 of the Planning Code for
6	Lincoln Park, formerly known as City Cemetery, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 1313, Lot
7	No. 029.

9	WHEREAS, On April 20, 2021, Supervisor Chan introduced a Resolution initiating a
10	landmark designation under Article 10 of the Planning Code for Lincoln Park, formerly known
11	as City Cemetery, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 1313, Lot No. 029, and extending the
12	prescribed time within which the Historic Preservation Commission may render it's decision by
13	90 days, for a total of 180 days ("the Resolution"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of
14	the Board of Supervisors in File No. 210426; and
15	WHEREAS, On July 27, 2021, the Board unanimously approved the Resolution, and
16	on August 4, 2021, the Resolution became effective; and
17	WHEREAS, On August 12, 2021, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the
18	proposed Ordinance to the Historic Preservation Commission; and
19	WHEREAS, Pursuant to the extension of time provided by the Resolution, the Historic
20	Preservation Commission has 180 days from the date of referral to the Commission to
21	approve, disapprove or modify the proposed designation; and
22	WHEREAS, Absent an extension, the Historic Preservation Commission's deadline to
23	act to approve, disapprove or modify the proposed designation is February 8, 2022, or 180
24	days from the referral of the Resolution to the Historic Preservation Commission, which
25	occurred on August 12, 2021; and

1	WHEREAS, Failure of the Historic Preservation Commission to act within 180 days
2	shall be deemed to constitute approval of the landmark designation; and
3	WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code, Section 1004.2(b) may, by
4	Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Historic Preservation Commission
5	may render its decision; and
6	WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Historic
7	Preservation Commission additional time to review the proposed landmark designation and
8	render its decision; now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
10	within which the Historic Preservation Commission may render its decision on the Resolution
11	for 90 additional days, until May 9, 2022.
