DPH received the letter of funding allocation on July 15th for a program period beginning July 1st. Upon receiving the letter of funding allocation, DPH staff began the process of gaining the required signatures and approvals from CAT, DHR, CON, and MYR to amend the Annual Salary Ordinance. Once the proper approvals were obtained, DPH staff prepared the legislation for introduction on November 16th.
