9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
11 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Brendan Mannix v. City and County of  
12 San Francisco, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-18-568967 by the payment  
13 of \$225,000. The lawsuit involves an employment dispute.
