13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
14	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding		
15	Article XII, to Chapter 2, to read as follows:		
16	ARTICLE XII. PUBLICATION OF NOTICES.		
17	SEC. 2.96. FINDINGS.		
18	(a) San Francisco C	Charter Article XVII, defines "Notice" to mean publication (as defined by	
19	ordinance), and a contemporaneous filing with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors or other		
20	appropriate office. Charter Article XVII further empowers the Board of Supervisors by ordinance to		
21	define the term "Published" and requires the Board of Supervisors to seek a recommendation from the		
22	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors before adopting such an ordinance. The Clerk of the Board of		
23	Supervisors participated in the drafting of this ordinance.		
24	(b) The City has greatly expanded its use of electronic media to provide information to the		
25	public, and individuals' acc	ess to those media has also expanded greatly. In adopting this Article XII	

1	the Board of Supervisors intends to: (1) maximize use of electronic media as a cost effective means of			
2	publishing notices; (2) provide uniform implementation of Charter Article XVII's "publication"			
3	requirement to the extent that implementation of this Article XII does not conflict with notice or			
4	publication requirements specifically imposed by federal or State law or by the San Francisco Charter			
5	or applicable City ordinances; (3) provide City agencies with a standard notice and publication			
6	procedure that future City legislation can incorporate; and (4) establish a mechanism to ensure that			
7	drafters of all future legislation that addresses publication and notice consider the use of this standard			
8	notice and publication procedure.			
9	SEC. 2.97. DEFINITIONS.			
10	(a) "City's Official Website Homepage" shall mean the first screen that opens at sfgov.org or			
11	any successor City official internet address.			
12	(b) "Department's Website Homepage" shall mean the first screen that opens at the			
13	Department's website address.			
14	(c) "Notices" shall mean all notices to the public required under the Charter.			
15	(d) "Published" shall mean posted on the City's Official Website Homepage, on the applicable			
16	Department's Website Homepage, and at the Main Branch of the San Francisco Public Library, as			
17	more fully described in Section 2.98.			
18	SEC. 2.98. PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS.			
19	(a) The City Librarian shall designate a place in the Main Branch of the Public Library,			
20	accessible to the public, for the posting of Notices in hard copy. The City Librarian shall cause such			
21	Notices to be posted promptly upon receipt. For purposes of this subsection (a), "posting" may include			
22	placing a notice in a file that is readily identifiable and available to the public.			
23	(b) The Department of Technology shall place on the City's Official Website Homepage a			
24	"Notices" section which shall include links to Notices of all City departments. The Department of			
25	<u>Technology shall cause such Notices to be posted promptly.</u>			

1	(c) City departments shall (1) transmit Notices to the Department of Technology for posting on
2	the City's Official Website Homepage; and (2) post Notices on the Department's Website Homepage,
3	either directly or through the Department of Technology, as applicable. The Department of
4	Technology shall cause such Notices to be posted promptly upon receipt.
5	(d) This Article is not intended to change (1) the duration of, or time during which City, State
6	or federal law requires an official or agency to publish or post a Notice; (2) the identity of the official
7	or agency responsible for publishing or posting a Notice; or (3) publication or posting requirements
8	that City, State or federal law otherwise impose on City officials or agencies.
9	(e) The publication requirements established in subsections (a), (b), and (c) above shall be
10	deemed satisfied if the City has substantially complied with the requirements, meaning the Notice has
11	been posted at the Main Branch of the Public Library, and on either the City's Official Website
12	Homepage or the Department's Website Homepage.
13	SEC. 2.99. REVIEW OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES.
14	The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall review all future proposed ordinances that have
15	been introduced that contain notice and publication requirements, and may recommend to the sponsor
16	of the legislation that the proposed ordinance incorporate the notice and publication requirements as
17	set forth in this Article XII, to the maximum extent consistent with federal and State law. The Clerk's
18	failure to perform this review on any ordinance shall not invalidate the ordinance, or form the basis for
19	any legal challenge to the ordinance.
20	SEC. 2.100. REGULATIONS.
21	The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, in consultation with the City Librarian and/or the
22	Director of the Department of Technology, to the extent the Clerk deems appropriate, may adopt
23	regulations, consistent with this Article XII and Charter Section 16.112, governing the operational
24	procedures for implementing the provisions set forth in this Article XII.
