11	Secti	etion 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San		
12	Francisco hereby find and determine that:			
13	(a)	San Franci	sco restaurants are one of the top reasons for visiting San Francisco,	
14	according to	g to the San Francisco Convention and Visitors Bureau.		
15	(b)	San Franci	sco is the birthplace of the Irish Coffee, the martini, cioppino, chicken	
16	tetrazzini, Joe's Special, Crab Louis and sourdough.			
17	(c)	San Franci	sco is also the birthplace for the organic food revolution and is the	
18	foundation of California cuisine.			
19	(d)	San Francisco became the second U.S. city and the only West Coast city to		
20	have a Michelin Guide, with more than 300 restaurants receiving the coveted stars or making			
21	the cut to be included in the prestigious guide.			
22	(e)	San Franci	sco boasts more restaurants per capita than any other cosmopolitan	
23	city in the U.S.			
24	(f)	Readers of	Bon Appétit consistently name San Francisco as the nation's top city	
25	for dining out.

6	Sect	Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by adding Section			
7	456.7, to read as follows:

9	(a) <u>T</u>	(a) The Department of Public Health shall:			
10	1.	Declare October as Restaurant Appreciation Month.			
11	2.	Establish criteria and an application and selection process to identify local restaurants			
12	that contribute to the vitality of San Francisco. The selected restaurants shall be recognized during at				
13	least one public event held during Restaurant Appreciation Month. The Mayor, individual members of				
14	the Board of	the Board of Supervisors, and the general public may nominate restaurants for recognition.			
15	<u>3.</u>	The criteria, application, and selection process should include a review and			
16	analysis of the restaurant's labor practices towards its employees including but not limited to				
17	employees' regular and overtime wage rates, the restaurants' break policies, tip policies,				
18	health and safety training protocols, worker's compensation insurance coverage plans, sick				
19	leave policies, health insurance or coverage options offered to employees, family leave				
20	policies, and non-discrimination policies or protocols.
