14 Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby
15 amended by amending Sections 3.1-107, 3.1-140, 3.1-150, 3.1-155, 3.1-175, 3.1-190, 3.1-
16 195, 3.1-205, 3.1-207, 3.1-218, 3.1-240, 3.1-245, 3.1-250, 3.1-251, 3.1-267, 3.1-275, 3.1-312,
17 3.1-315, 3.1-320, 3.1-325, 3.1-355, 3.1-362, 3.1-365, 3.1-390, 3.1-422, 3.1-445, and 3.1-450
18 to read as follows:

19 SEC. 3.1-107. - DISCLOSURE CATEGORY 1.

20 Unless otherwise specified, for each department or agency, Disclosure Category 1
21 shall read:

22 "Disclosure Category 1. Persons in this category shall disclose income (*including gifts*)
23 from any source, interests in real property, investments, and all business positions in which
24 the designated employee is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holds any
25 position of management."
