WHEREAS, Almost forty thousand lives are lost to gun violence every year, for an average of 100 people shot and killed in the United States every day; and

WHEREAS, Every day 316 people are shot in the United States; and WHEREAS, Gun violence is the leading cause of death for children and teens in the United States; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco is not immune to the national gun violence epidemic, as our communities have seen a dramatic increase in gun violence within the past year; and

WHEREAS, Black Americans are disproportionately impacted by gun violence, experiencing 10 times the gun homicides, 18 times the gun assault injuries, and nearly 3 times the fatal police shootings of white Americans; and

WHEREAS, Almost every industry in the United States can be held liable for the harm their products cause, and the gun industry is not held to the same standard; and

WHEREAS, The Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA) shields gun producers and dealers from civil liability when their products are used to commit crimes, when those companies break state law; and WHEREAS, Existing law defines a public nuisance and provides that a public nuisance may be remedied by an indictment or information, a civil action, or abatement; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill No. 1594 empowers local and state governments and Californians to sue those responsible for the manufacturing, sale, distribution and marketing that contribute to conditions that endanger the health or safety of others or engaging in unfair business practices; and

WHEREAS, The threat of civil litigation aims to compel the gun industry to take every step possible to prevent illegal sales and theft to reduce gun violence; and

WHEREAS, The bill is co-sponsored by the California Attorney General and the Brady Campaign; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports Assembly Bill No. 1594; and, be it
