Dear Board of Supervisors,

The undersigned coalitions, organizations, and labor unions are proud supporters of the **Union At Home** ordinance, recommended on February 7 by the Rules Committee for passage by this full Board. We ask the Board to approve this ordinance today.

During the course of the pandemic, tenant counseling clinics have heard from 2-3 times the number of tenants as before the pandemic. Counselors expect this trend to continue. At the same time, too many tenants are self-evicting before tenant counselors ever reach them. Tenant counselors often learn about this displacement when one tenant in the building calls us, and in the course of describing the issues they are facing, shares that multiple neighbors have already moved due to the same conditions.

The apartment industry is showing us how it is not only recovering from the pandemic but also expanding because of it. Investor activity is up, transaction volumes have not only recovered from their pandemic low but are out-pacing pre-pandemic levels, San Francisco rents are rising and are expected to increase by 6.5% in 2022, and investment firms are consolidating their holdings.

We caught a glimpse of the consolidation during the December hearings on Proposition I funds for property acquisition, when we learned that, on a list of 117 apartment buildings for sale on the private market, 99 of the sellers were individuals or families with no connections to big real estate, in contrast to the entities who were -- and still are -- lining up to buy those homes.

Under similar conditions for our lives at work, we would choose to organize and form a labor union. Through self-organization and collective bargaining, we would assert our voices, improve our working conditions, and secure dignity and respect on the job. For our lives at home as renters, we should have similar infrastructure in our laws to enable association and collective bargaining with landlords.

When tenants exercise this ordinance in the future, they will be empowering themselves and creating one of the best countervailing forces capable of correcting an unequal balance of power: a union. We've known it for decades for our lives at work, and now it's time to bring it home. Our organizations and labor unions have thousands of members who rent in SF. Thank you, and we urge the Board to approve this ordinance.
