Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Attached please find a copy of the proposed Ordinance for the Board of Supervisors approval, which retroactively authorizes the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,350,000 from the State of California Board of State and Community Corrections for the County Resentencing Pilot Program for the grant period September 1, 2021 through September 1, 2024.

The retroactive request is due to the receipt of the award notice in November 2021 which is after the County Resentencing Pilot Program's start date of September 1, 2021. No grant activities have begun and no expenditures have been incurred.

The purpose of the grant is to support the County Resentencing Pilot Program's two-fold goal: 1) ensure that the District Attorney in each county has the resources needed to exercise their discretion under PC 1170(d)(1); and 2) evaluate a collaborative approach to exercising prosecutorial resentencing discretion. The County Resentencing Pilot Program was established via the State Budget trailer bill <u>SB 145</u>.
