[Urging Release of Leonard Peltier from Federal Custody - Declaring February 24, 2022 as a

WHEREAS, San Francisco sits on the unceded ancestral homeland of the Ramaytush Ohlone; and

WHEREAS, Leonard Peltier has been incarcerated for over 46 years as a political prisoner; and

WHEREAS, Overwhelming evidence indicates that Leonard Peltier was not responsible for the murder of the two FBI agents killed June 26, 1975. on the Pine Ridge Reservation; and

WHEREAS, There is even more evidence that prosecutors in Mr. Peltier's case acted improperly, including withholding exculpatory evidence, perjured witnesses, and intimidating witnesses; and

WHEREAS, Former Federal Judge Kevin Sharp has declared Leonard Peltier's innocence on the grounds that he was denied his Constitutional right to a fair trial and has requested his release from Federal prison; and

WHEREAS, Leonard Peltier at age 77, an elder who has recently contracted Covid-19, and is known to have preexisting diabetes, making him susceptible to additional high-risk medical conditions; and

WHEREAS, Peltier has been incarcerated over 46 years which, under United Nations guidelines, constitutes cruel and unusual punishment; and

WHEREAS, Amnesty International supports a Clemency or Home Confinement for Leonard Peltier; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, Let it be known that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declare their support for an Executive Clemency or Home Confinement for Leonard Peltier, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby declares February 24, 2022, as A Day of Solidarity with Leonard Peltier.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to transmit a copy of this Resolution to President Joe Biden, House Speaker Nancy Pelosi, Senate Majority Leader Charles Schumer, and Attorney General Merrick Garland.
