

1 [Accept and Expend Grant –Tanzania Support President’s Emergency AIDS Plan- \$27,062.]

2 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
3 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$27,062 from the University of**
4 **California San Francisco (UCSF), to participate in a program entitled “Tanzania UCSF**
5 **Technical Assistance to Support the President’s Emergency Plan for AIDS;” for the**
6 **period of April 1, 2010 through September 29, 2010.**

7 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the Centers for Disease
8 Control (CDC) supporting the Tanzania UCSF Technical Assistance to Support the
9 President’s Emergency Plan for AIDS; and,

10 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, UCSF has subcontracted with DPH in the
11 amount of \$27,062 for the period of April 1, 2010 through September 29, 2010; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF requires the City to
13 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
14 Board of Supervisors in File No. 101323; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
15 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
17 for one existing position, one Epidemiologist II (Job Class 2803) at .35 FTE, for six months
18 during the period from April 1, 2010 through September 29, 2010; and,

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1 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
2 receive notification of the contract until September 8, 2010 for a project start date of April 1,
2010; and,

3 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$2,899;
4 now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
6 in the amount of \$27,062 from UCSF; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
8 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
12 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
the agreement expires.
