WHEREAS, The San Francisco Parks Trust ("Parks Trust"), a non-profit organization acting as fiscal agent; and

WHEREAS, Through the Gear-up Fundraising Campaign has secured equipment and furnishings valued at \$155,013 which they will gift (Gift) to the Recreation and Park Department; and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission approved the acceptance of the Gift from the Gear-up Campaign on March 4, 2010, under Resolution No. 1003-002 ("Commission Resolution"); and

WHEREAS, Under the aforementioned Commission Resolution, the Recreation and Park Commission recommends to the Board of Supervisors to accept the Gift; now, therefore, be it

Dear President Buell:

Now that San Francisco Parks Trust (SFPT) has fulfilled all the requests for equipment and furnishings for five newly- renovated Recreation & Park Department recreation centers through the GearUp Fund, we are able to fund other recreation needs. We are donating an additional \$15,000 for special needs across the City.

Through our work with a number of Recreation Directors we learned that many rec centers often lack relatively small items to keep their programs running. We are setting up this \$15,000 special fund to pay for these items through a series of "gifts-in-place" ranging from \$500-\$1,500 to ensure that the lack of supplies and equipment does not impede sports, fitness, athletic, arts and cultural activities at recreation centers.

SFPT's contacts with Bank of America led to knowledge of the closure of their fitness center in downtown San Francisco, and resulting availability of a large amount of fitness equipment in good to excellent condition. SFPT has secured the donation of several treadmills, stationary bicycles, rowing machines, weight machines, free weights & benches, step boards, exercise mats and other apparatus. Dear President Buell:

I am pleased to let you know of further progress in San Francisco Parks Trust's (SFPT) efforts to provide equipment and furnishings for RPD's newly renovated Recreation Centers. Since my letter of February 26th, we have received a contribution of \$20,000 from Koret Foundation for Hamilton Recreation Center, and contributions of \$40,000, \$20,000, and \$10,000 from the David B. Gold Foundation, Sports Basement, and the Mimi and Peter Haas Fund, respectively, along with many smaller gifts, to benefit all five centers covered by the GearUp Fund. We now request that the Commission accept a gift of \$100,000 as follows:

- A \$50,000 in-kind gift for Harvey Milk Center for Recreational Arts, to provide equipment for the Photo Center and Music Studio;
- A \$40,000 in-kind gift for Hamilton-Recreation Center, for provide equipment for the Center's pool, programs, and staff offices;
- A \$5,000 in-kind gift for Sunnyside Clubhouse, for Tots (age 5 and under) program supplies and equipment; and
- A \$5,000 in-kind gift for historic Sunnyside Conservatory, for furniture to enable its use for RPD programs and as a rental space.

As you know, the GearUp Fund was established by our trustees in October 2009 at the request of General Manager Phil Ginsburg, to provide "furniture, fixtures, and equipment" to Hamilton, Harvey Milk, Midtown Terrace, Sunnyside Clubhouse, and Sunnyside Conservatory. There are a few needs outstanding and we hope to be able to meet those as well, but we have surpassed our goal of \$125,000.

I am pleased to let you know that San Francisco Parks Trust (SFPT) is making progress in our efforts to provide equipment and furnishings for RPD's newly renovated Recreation Centers, and we now request that the Commission accept a gift of \$30,000 from our GearUp Fund, as follows:

- A \$25,000 in-kind gift of pool and fitness equipment for Hamilton Recreation Center. Grant funds were provided by the Bothin Foundation, with the stipulation that SFPT purchase the equipment;
