21	(a) In November 2016, California voters approved Proposition 64, the Control,				
22	Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act ("Proposition 64"), which legalized adult use				
23	cannabis in California for individuals 21 years of age and older. SB 129 (Stats. 2021, Ch. 69				
24	created the Local Jurisdiction Assistance Grant Program, administered by the Department of

Staff duties may include researching, analyzing and making policy recommendations; directing complex financial and operational activities; responding to informational requests, and representing the office to the Mayor's office, Board of Supervisors, Controller's Office, other city officials, and outside agencies and the public, as well as providing administrative analysis to high-level city officials regarding the commercial cannabis application process.
