On February 17, 2022, the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control accepted an application for a person to person and premises to premises transfer of a type 21, Off-Sale General license for Bear Eagle Inc., dba: SFGIFTBASKETS.COM, a small specialty retail shop located on the ground level at 2 Embarcadero Center, Suite R-2105, in San Francisco.

The shop features and highlights gift baskets and other gift items. Some of the gift baskets offered include a bottle of wine. The shop receives orders for the gift baskets by telephone, email, mail and from persons visiting the store. The gift baskets that include wine are shipped to the recipients. No over the counter sales of gift baskets with wine are allowed to be taken by the purchaser out of the shop. Gift baskets with wine can only be shipped to the intended recipient based on the regulations pertaining to the current type 85 Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license.

The shop has been licensed with an ABC type 85, Limited Off-Sale – Wine license since December 3, 2015 with no record of disciplinary actions by ABC. This allows the shop to include a bottle of wine in a gift basket. Applicant wishes to obtain a type 21 Off-Sale General license in order to expand the variety of alcoholic beverages allowed to be included in the gift baskets by adding the options of including beer and distilled spirits.

The intended premises address in San Francisco is located in Supervisor Aaron Peskin's District 3. The location is within census tract #0105.00 which allows for two (2) Off-Sale type ABC licenses within the census tract, based on the most recent estimated population count. At the present time, eleven (11) Off-Sale type licenses are issued within this census tract. The census tract is deemed to be over-concentrated at this time with Off-Sale type licenses. If the type 21 license is approved for this location, the applicant will cancel their type 85 license resulting in no increase of the number of off-sale licenses within the census tract.

The premises is located within San Francisco Police Department's reporting beat #152. There are 654 total reporting beats within San Francisco with a total of 55,022 reported offenses. The average number of offenses per district is 84.13. The total number of reported offenses within reporting beat #152 is 193. The reporting beat is considered high crime for it exceeds the 120% average number of offenses which is 100.8.

Due to the undue-concentration, and the designation of high crime, the applicant is required by Section 23958.4 of the Business and Professions Code to apply for a "PCN" review by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors. After review of all pertinent facts regarding this premises and the surrounding area, applicant hopes and wishes that the Board will find that the issuance of the applied-for type 21 Off-Sale General license will fulfill the public's convenience or necessity.

#### ABC LICENSE INFORMATION:

#### Current license issued to premises:

Type 85, Limited Off-Sale – Wine license. License originally issued on December 3, 2015 to Mitra Ghiasi, a sole proprietor. License was transferred to Bear Eagle Inc., a corporation, on September 6, 2021. There is no record of any ABC disciplinary actions against the license under the original and the new ownership.

ABC's description of the type 85 license – The Limited Off Sale Wine License allows for the sale of wine to consumers for consumption off the licensed premises. Sales are restricted to those solicited and accepted via direct mail, telephone, or the Internet and may not be conducted from a retail premises open to the public.

The current type 85 license is issued to the back counter and storage areas of the shop which is not accessible to the public. The shop area that is accessible to the public has gift baskets and other gift items displayed. Walk-in customers cannot purchase a gift basket with wine over the counter and take it out of the shop. Gift baskets with wine can only be shipped to the recipient of the gift basket away from the premises.

ABC type 21, Off-Sale General (beer, wine and distilled spirits) is being purchased from 2135 Buchanan Street, located within Supervisor Catherine Stefani's District 2. The current ABC application is requesting transfer of ownership from the current licensee to the applicant and from the current licensee's location to the applicant's location at 2 Embarcadero Center, Suite R-2105, which is located within Supervisor Aaron Peskin's District 3.

Current status of license: License is Surrendered to ABC (indicating that the license privileges are not being utilized at this time) and the business is closed.

Current status: Premises is open and operating with an ABC type 85 Limited Off-Sale – Wine license as a small specialty retail shop offering gift baskets (with and without wine) and other gift and tourist items. If approved, the premises will be licensed with a type 21 Off-Sale General license to offer a wider variety of alcoholic beverages for their gift baskets.

#### APPLICANT INFORMATION:

Bear Eagle Inc., a California corporation, is owned by Cheryl J. Maloney (50% stockholder) and Olga Antipova (50% stockholder). Cheryl J. Maloney's primary occupation is a realty agent for Vanguard Properties in San Francisco. Olga Antipova's primary occupation is a dentist at Cosmo Dental in San Francisco.

Bear Eagle Inc. is registered with the California Secretary of State as a general stock corporation as of November 19, 2020. The current status of the corporation is "active".

#### BUSIENSS OPERATION INFORMATION:

SFGIFTBASKETS.COM is a specialty gift basket shop located in the ground level within Embarcadero 2 in the Financial District. The shop offers gift baskets, with and without wine, along with other gift and tourist items. The gift baskets which include wine cannot be sold directly to the public at the shop. All gift baskets with wine must be ordered and then shipped to the recipient. No customer can order a gift basket with wine and then take the basket with wine form the shop. The basket with wine can only be shipped.

The ownership of the shop wishes to expand the variety of off-sale alcoholic beverages it can include with its gift baskets and to be allowed to sell gift baskets with an alcoholic beverage to a customer at the shop who may then take the basket with them out of the shop. The type of ABC license that would permit this is the type 21 Off-Sale General license which will allow for off-sale beer, wine and distilled spirits.

The shop is located in a mixed-use area of retail stores, restaurants, financial institutions and offices in the Financial District. The store is located within Embarcadero 2, on the ground floor near the center of the building. The shop is not visible from the surrounding streets. Surrounding streets are Davis, Sacramento, Front and Clay Streets.

The addition of the type 21 license to the shop should not create an increase in vehicle or pedestrian traffic in the area. The Embarcadero complex of office buildings offer both street and off-street parking spaces.

No other store in the immediate area is a small specialty retail shop offering gift baskets, other gift items and tourist related items.

The applicant is applying to ABC for a person to person and premises to premises transfer (double transfer) of the type 21 Off-Sale General license for the business to provide patrons the opportunity and convenience to include beer, wine, and/or distilled spirits in the gift baskets that can be ordered by internet, telephone, mail or in-person.

The store's hours of operation are from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, 11:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturday and 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm on Sunday. Estimated percentage of alcoholic beverage sales, as compared to all other retail items, is estimated to be 25-30%. A copy of ABC form ABC-257, Licensed Premises Diagram and Planned Operation (Retail) is attached for your review.

#### SUBSTANTIATION FOR A POSITIVE FINDING OF PUBLIC CONVENEINCE OR NECESSITY:

- The issuance of the applied-for license would be a benefit to local business employees, office workers from the Embarcadero Center buildings and surrounding Financial District offices, patrons of other business in the area, local workers, persons visiting the area and tourists.
- The issuance of the applied-for license would be a benefit to persons on the inter-net ordering gift baskets to be shipped to recipients in the City, the Bay Area, the State of California and the United States.
- The intended premises operating hours are catered to local business and office workers in the Financial District and Embarcadero Center, daytime visitors and tourists walking through Embarcadero 2.
- 4. The intended premises will operate as a gift and gift basket store and not as a liquor store.

- 5. The issuance of the applied-for license would benefit the public in general at this location for the premises is unique and there are no other like premises in the area that offers the gifts, gift baskets and other items that this premises offers.
- Current public transportation that serves the area is the San Francisco Municipal Railway and BART (Bay Area Rapid Transit). Other public transportation serving the area is a variety of established public taxi cabs and other private taxi cab type services (Uber, Lyft, etc.).

#### SUMMARY:

The premises will be a small specialty gift and gift basket shop where at the option of the purchaser an alcoholic beverage may be included in the gift basket. The issuance of the ABC license would benefit those who live and work in the immediate area, countless persons who visit and travel through the area and persons placing orders by mail, the internet and by telephone. It would be a convenience to the public for the premises to be able to offer off-sale beer, wine and distilled spirits while they patronize the premises for its gifts, gift baskets and other items.

The Applicant wishes for the Board to consider the above facts and hopes that they find that the issuance of the applied-for Off-Sale type 21 Off-Sale General license would fulfill the public's convenience or necessity and allow the issuance of said license.


