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3	Resolution approving and authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Mayor's Office
4	of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") to execute grant agreements with
5	Catholic Charities (CYO) of the Archdiocese of San Francisco, Eviction Defense
6	Collaborative, Inc., and Mission Neighborhood Centers, Inc. for the distribution of
7	COVID-19 rental assistance through MOHCD's Emergency Rental Assistance Program
8	to eligible San Francisco tenants and landlords, in an aggregate amount not to exceed
9	\$40,550,000 with a total funding amount of \$56,550,000 for COVID-19 rental assistance;
10	approving the form of and authorizing the execution of the grant agreements; and
11	granting general authority to City officials to take actions necessary to implement this
12	Resolution, as defined herein.
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14	WHEREAS, The CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program, administered by the State
15	Department of Housing and Community Development, provides financial assistance for
16	unpaid rent to eligible renters and landlords who have been impacted by COVID-19; and
17	WHEREAS, More than \$89 million in CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program funds have
18	been provided to more than 7,800 households in San Francisco; and
19	WHEREAS, The current need for rent relief exceeds the remaining available CA
20	COVID-19 Rent Relief program funds, and the need to continue rent relief to San Franciscan
21	renters is urgent; and
22	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, acting through the Mayor's Office
23	of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD"), administers a variety of eviction and
24	displacement prevention programs that provide legal assistance, education, outreach, tenant-
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1	landlord mediation, technical assistance to housing providers, and emergency rental
2	assistance and tenant-based subsidies; and
3	WHEREAS, MOHCD issued a Request for Proposals dated April 9, 2021, for San
4	Francisco community-based organizations to provide rent relief to San Francisco renters;
5	WHEREAS, MOHCD has provided grants to community-based organizations to provide
6	Emergency Rental Assistance Program ("ERAP") services as well as Federally funded and
7	locally funded COVID-19 Rent Relief program funds to tenants and landlords, as follows: (1) a
8	grant of \$6,000,000 to Catholic Charities (CYO) of the Archdiocese of San Francisco, (2) a
9	grant of \$6,000,000 to Eviction Defense Collaborative, Inc., (3) a grant of \$4,000,000 to
10	Mission Neighborhood Centers, Inc. (collectively, "Rent Relief Community Organizations"),
11	and the fully executed grant agreements are on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No.
12	220211; and
13	WHEREAS, The Fiscal Years (FYs) 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 Annual Appropriation
14	Ordinance allocated \$32,000,000 of General Fund, one time, to augment State and Federal
15	rent relief funds; and
16	WHEREAS, \$10,000,000 in Our City, Our Home funding has been allocated from the
17	Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing to MOHCD to support additional rent
18	relief, and
19	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 48-21 appropriated \$10,050,000 to the COVID-19 Rent
20	Resolution and Rent Relief Fund under Administrative Code, Section 10.100-51.1 (the
21	"Fund"), which sets forth the use and administration of the Fund; and;
22	WHEREAS, MOHCD has determined that San Francisco renters continue to need rent
23	relief due to the economic impacts of COVID-19, and recommends approval of an increase of
24	grant funds to the Rent Relief Community Organizations to further assist such renters in San
25	Francisco; and

WHEREAS, MOHCD desires to provide an additional grant to Catholic Charities (CYO)		
of the Archdiocese of San Francisco in an amount not to exceed \$14,100,000 for an		
aggregate grant amount of \$20,100,000 pursuant to a new Grant Agreement in substantially		
the form on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 220211, and in such final form as		
approved by the Director of MOHCD and the City Attorney ("CYO Agreement"); and		
WHEREAS, MOHCD desires to provide an additional grant to Eviction Defense		
Collaborative, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$16,600,000 for an aggregate grant amount of		

Collaborative, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$16,600,000 for an aggregate grant amount of \$22,600,000 pursuant to a new Grant Agreement in substantially the form on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 220211, and in such final form as approved by the Director of MOHCD and the City Attorney ("EDC Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, MOHCD desires to provide an additional grant to Mission Neighborhood Centers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$9,850,000 for an aggregate grant amount of \$13,850,000 pursuant to a new Grant Agreement in substantially the form on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 220211, and in such final form as approved by the Director of MOHCD and the City Attorney ("MNC Agreement," and together with the CYO Agreement and the EDC Agreement, collectively, the "Grant Agreements"); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the existing grant agreements with the Rent Relief Community Organizations and the new Grant Agreements, and authorizes the Mayor and the Director of MOHCD or the Director's designee to enter into the Grant Agreements for the administration and distribution of COVID-19 rental assistance through the ERAP (including, without limitation, modifications of the Grant Agreements, and preparation and attachment of, or changes to, any of all of the exhibits and ancillary agreements) and any other documents or instruments necessary in connection therewith, that the Director determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities for the City or materially diminish

1	the benefits of the City, or are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes and intent of
2	this Resolution and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including the City Charter; and,
3	be it
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions authorized and directed by this Resolution and
5	heretofore taken are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed by this Board of Supervisors;
6	and be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreements being
8	fully executed by all parties, MOHCD shall provide each fully executed Grant Agreements to
9	Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
