LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1608, as introduced, Gipson. County officers: consolidation of offices.

Existing law authorizes the board of supervisors of a county to consolidate the duties of various county offices in various combinations, including combining the duties of the sheriff and the coroner.

This bill would delete the authority to combine the duties of the sheriff with the duties of the coroner.
