

The impact of housing instability on birthing people and their families

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
Increasing housing instability \rightarrow increased preterm birth.



San Francisco has tremendous inequities in housing and birth outcomes.

 Black birthing people have ~9X likelihood of housing instability in pregnancy compared to general population in SF.

 Black birthing people have 2X likelihood of having a preterm birth compared to white women in SF.



Birth outcomes

Pregnancy loss
Preterm birth
Small for gestational age
Congenital syphilis



Childhood outcomes

Neonatal death
Developmental delay
Hearing, vision, respiratory
problems
Learning challenges
Parental separation, foster care



Maternal/birthing person outcomes

STIs, HIV, Hep C

Untreated medical conditions

Substance use disorders

Mental illness/PTSD

Overdose

Death
