10	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
11	Section 16.700, to read as follows:
12	SEC. 16.700. PARTICIPATION.
13	The following shall be eligible to participate in the Health Service System:
14	(a) City and County employees.
15	(1) All permanent employees of the City and County of San Francisco whose normal
16	work week at the time of inclusion is the system in not less than twenty (20) hours;
17	(2) All regularly scheduled provisional employees of the City and County of San
18	Francisco whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in the system is not less than
19	twenty (20) hours;
20	(3) All other employees of the City and County of San Francisco, including "as
21	needed" employees, who have worked one thousand and forty hours (1040) in any
22	consecutive twelve (12) month period and whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in
23	the system is not less than twenty (20) hours.
