This letter is a request for a PC or N determination for a new Type 64 Liquor License for THELOSTCHURCH.ORG, INC's non-profit theater at 665 Chestnut. The proposed hours of operation for this theater are 6:30pm-11:30pm 7 days a week. Their application was received by the ABC on March 29th, 2022; and the Notification poster was posted the same day in the window of the entrance to 665 Chestnut. On March 7th, 2022 Radius Services was employed for the neighborhood notification mailers, which are expected to go out on March 15th. The Lost Church's 99 seat theater at 665 Chestnut will serve up and coming artists and performers, as well as the local community; by hosting acoustic performances of magic, music, poetry, comedy and local theater. Though there are far more Artists and Performers who can use a 99 seat theater than a 499 seat theater, these are the hardest to keep alive due to the extensive permitting and overhead of running a theater; but with limited ticket sale revenue. The Type 64 Liquor License is necessary financially that the small theater may survive, and that the paying audiences might enjoy a beverage before the show, during intermission and possibly after the show; which adds to their overall experience of a night of acoustic entertainment. This letter is necessary due to the higher crime rate of North Beach, however there are numerous performance spaces in the neighboring blocks such as Cobb's Comedy Club, and Bimbo's 365 who cater to larger audiences and performers. For these reasons we are asking for a Determination of Public Convenience or Necessity be issued.
