3 **Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a**
4 **Gift from the John and Lisa Pritzker Family Fund for \$54,021 annually for FYs 2010-11,**
5 **2011-12, and 2012-13 (for a total of \$162,063) for general operating support of Joseph**
6 **Lee Recreation Center.**

8 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department has a budget shortfall; and

9 WHEREAS, Given the current budget crisis the Recreation and Park Department has
10 had to close all City recreation centers two days per week (Sundays and Mondays); and

11 WHEREAS, The John and Lisa Pritzker Family Fund is concerned about the negative
12 impact that these closures will have on the department's ability to deliver programs and
13 services, especially in underserved areas; and

14 WHEREAS, The Joseph Lee Recreation Center, located in the Bay View Hunters
15 Point neighborhood, hosts programs for youth, adults and seniors and provides opportunities
16 for sports, after-school enrichment and the cultural arts; and

17 WHEREAS, The annual operating cost the Joseph Lee Recreation Center is \$378,147;
18 and

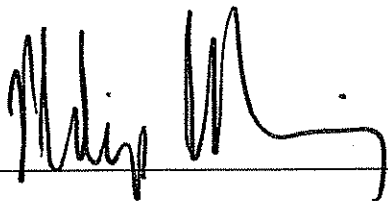
19 WHEREAS, The John and Lisa Pritzker Family Fund intends for their gift to support an
20 extra day of programming per week at the Joseph Recreation Center, now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Gift and authorizes the
22 Recreation and Park Department General Manager to accept and expend the Gift, and to
23 perform all acts required of the City thereunder; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City
25 with respect to the Gift are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and
2 Park General Manager to enter into any modifications to the Gift that the Recreation and Park
3 General Manager determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests
4 of the City and do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are
5 necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Gift or this Resolution, and are in
6 compliance with all applicable laws, including the City's Charter.

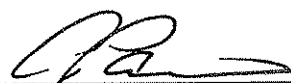

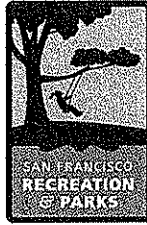

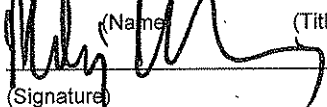
