6 WHEREAS, The California Secretary of State has indicated that Mayor Gavin Newsom
7 currently has the most votes for the Office of Lieutenant Governor and, if Mayor Newsom
8 continues to lead, his assumption to that office in January 2011 would create a vacancy in the
9 Office of the Mayor; and

10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Charter Section 13.101.5(b)
11 provides that when a vacancy occurs in the Office of the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors may
12 appoint a successor Mayor; and

13 WHEREAS, The Charter and San Francisco Administrative Code are silent on the
14 process to be used for the selection of a successor Mayor, but the Board has considerable
15 discretion in creating such a process; and

16 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City and County of San Francisco that the
17 Board of Supervisors establish a fair and orderly process to be used for the selection of a
18 successor Mayor before such a vacancy arises; now, therefore, be it

19 MOVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San
20 Francisco be directed to prepare and provide a process to govern the Board of Supervisors'
21 nomination and appointment of a successor Mayor; and, be it

22 FURTHER MOVED, That said process shall be presented for review and approval by
23 the Board of Supervisors at its next regularly scheduled meeting on November 23, 2010.
