Motion directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to propose a process for nominating and selecting a successor Mayor.

[Process for Nominating and Selecting a Successor Mayor]

WHEREAS, The California Secretary of State has indicated that Mayor Gavin Newsom currently has the most votes for the Office of Lieutenant Governor and, if Mayor Newsom continues to lead, his assumption to that office in January 2011 would create a vacancy in the Office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Charter Section 13.101.5(b) provides that when a vacancy occurs in the Office of the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors may appoint a successor Mayor; and

WHEREAS, The Charter and San Francisco Administrative Code are silent on the process to be used for the selection of a successor Mayor, but the Board has considerable discretion in creating such a process; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City and County of San Francisco that the Board of Supervisors establish a fair and orderly process to be used for the selection of a successor Mayor before such a vacancy arises; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco be directed to prepare and provide a process to govern the Board of Supervisors' nomination and appointment of a successor Mayor; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That said process shall be presented for review and approval by the Board of Supervisors at its next regularly scheduled meeting on November 23, 2010.
