

As required by Section 10.100-305 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, attached please find an original and four copies of a proposed resolution.

This resolution authorizes the Department of Public Health to accept a gift of merchandise in the amount of approximately \$2,000 and a gift of goods, furniture, fixtures and equipment in the amount of \$12,000 from the Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc., for a total monetary value of approximately \$14,000. Because this gift is not expressly for the direct benefit and welfare of the patients of Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center, we bring this item forward to the Board of Supervisors for their consideration and approval.

The donated goods are being used at Laguna Honda to run a general store, which is part of the hospital's vocational rehabilitation program and is managed by Laguna Honda staff with the participation of patients. Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc. has discontinued operating the gift shop and has decided to make a gift of the store's assets to Laguna Honda. The new Laguna Honda opens in December 2010; the operation of the gift shop is planned to be transferred to the Laguna Honda Foundation after the opening of the new hospital.
