Attached please find a copy of the proposed Resolution for the Board of Supervisors approval, which retroactively authorizes the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend an in-kind gift estimated at \$250,000 from the University of San Francisco School of Law's Racial Justice Clinic (RJC) to continue to fund two staff attorney positions to support the RJC's work assisting the Office of the District Attorney's Sentencing Review Conviction Unit and Wrongful Conviction Unit, which is supported by an all-volunteer Innocence Commission from November 2021 through November 2022.

The retroactive request is due to the receipt of the in-kind gift letters in 2022 which is after the funding start date of November 2021.

The purpose of the gift is to continue to fund two staff attorneys by the University of San Francisco School of Law's Racial Justice Clinic to support the District Attorney's reexamination of cases to identify cases involving excessive sentences and wrongful convictions.
