WHEREAS, Amendment No. 4 is substantially in the form attached and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 220175, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein;

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires the Board of Supervisors to approve by Resolution contracts estimated to cost the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, CCT Technologies, Inc. dba Computerland of Silicon Valley ("Contractor") was competitively awarded the Agreement through a Request for Proposals (RFP, Sourcing Event ID 0000000974) issued by the Office of Contract Administration on June 20, 2018, pursuant to Administrative Code, Chapter 21.1, in which City selected Contractor as a qualified proposer pursuant to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, The Contractor was one of 29 Proposers selected pursuant to the RFP, which resulted in three tiers of contractors; and

WHEREAS, The contracts awarded pursuant to the RFP are part of the City's Technology Marketplace (previously known at the "Computer Store") which originated in the 1990's as an efficient purchasing model for the City's evolving technology needs; and

WHEREAS, The Technology Marketplace contracts provide an efficient purchasing model City departments to purchase technology goods and services on an as-needed basis based on departments' specific business needs and reduces the amount of time needed to complete a transaction from several months to one to two weeks; and

WHEREAS, All Technology Marketplace transactions above established thresholds must be competitively solicited to all Technology Marketplace contractors within their respective tiers and 78% of the total amount awarded to Contractor through the Technology Marketplace process was awarded pursuant to a solicitation; and

WHEREAS, The Local Business Entity ("LBE") subcontracting participation requirement for the Agreement is 15% of the total value of professional services awarded to the Contractor and 10% of the total value of training services awarded to the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, The Civil Services approval of this Agreement has been granted under File No. 44114-17/18; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement commenced on January 1, 2019, with an initial term of three years through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement increased the not to exceed amount from \$20,000,000 to \$23,000,000 (File No. 190877); and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement increased the not to exceed amount from \$23,000,000 to \$44,000,000 (File No. 200936);

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement extended the Agreement end date by two years to December 31, 2023, which extension did not require approval by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Purchaser and Director of the Office of Contract Administration to execute Amendment No. 4 to Contract 1000012604 with CCT Technologies, Inc. dba Computerland of Silicon Valley for the purchase of

technology products and specialized services on an as-needed basis; increasing the contract amount by \$18,900,000 for a total not to exceed amount of \$62,900,000 with no change to the contract duration of five years from January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2023; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the contract being fully executed by all parties, the Purchaser and Director of the Office of Contract Administration shall provide the final contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
