WHEREAS, Community-based doulas remove barriers by meeting families prenatally and postpartum in the home; and

WHEREAS, Community-based doulas address maternal health disparities; and WHEREAS, Doulas across San Francisco help create positive childbirth experience and work towards improved birth and infant health outcomes; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby declares March 29 through April 5, 2022, as the first-ever Community-Based Doula Week in San Francisco.
