**Subject:** **File No. 220494.** Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to adjust existing surcharges on permit fees, license fees, permit review fees, and permit and license renewal fees for permits and licenses issued by the Planning Department, Department of Building Inspection, Department of Public Works, Department of Public Health, Police Department, and the Entertainment Commission that may be appealed to the Board of Appeals; and affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.

If this legislation passes, amendments to the Administrative Code would adjust existing surcharges on permit, license, permit review and renewal fees imposed in connection with permits and licenses issued, approved or renewed by the designated City departments, based on each department's history of appeals filed with the Board of Appeals and consistent with the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget for the Board of Appeals. The surcharges reflected in the Administrative Code have been adjusted annually to reflect changes in the consumer price index pursuant to Section 10G.2 of the Administrative Code; the current surcharges as adjusted since the last ordinance that updated the surcharges are as follows: Planning Department, \$22.50; Department of Building Inspection, \$22.50; Department of Public Works, \$9.00; Police Department, \$6.00; Entertainment Commission, \$4.00; Department of Public Health, \$50.50. These amendments updates the references for surcharges applicable to the Planning Department, Department of Building Inspection, Department of Public Works, Police Department, Entertainment Commission, and the Department of Public Health. The proposed ordinance will adjust the surcharges in Section 10G.1 in the Administrative Code as follows: Planning Department, increased from \$18.50 to \$37.00; Department of Building Inspection, increased from \$18.50 to \$37.00; Department of Public Works, increased from \$6.50 to \$9.00; Police Department, reduced from \$6:00 to \$3.00, Entertainment Commission, reduced from \$4.00 to \$2.00; Department of Public Health, increased from \$3.00 to \$45.00.

In accordance with Administrative Code, Section 67.7-1, persons who are unable to attend the hearing on this matter may submit written comments prior to the time the hearing begins. 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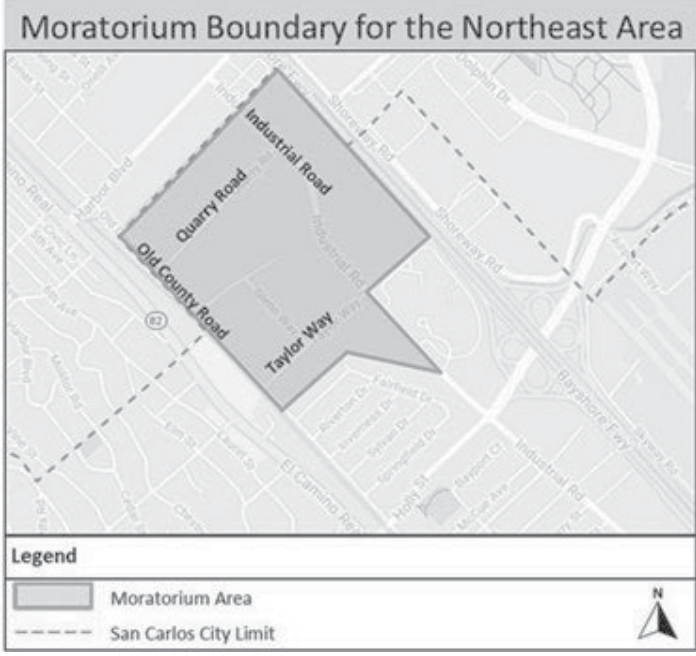

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Carlos City Council will hold a Public Hearing in the Council Chambers, City Hall – 600 Elm Street, San Carlos, on **Monday, May 23, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, pursuant to authority set forth in California Government Code section 65858 (b) and noticed in accordance with California Government Code section 65090, to consider the extension and possible modification to the scope of an interim ordinance which established a moratorium on the submission, consideration, or approval of applications for (i) lot line adjustments or the subdivision of land within the Northeast Area in accordance with the City of San Carlos Subdivision Regulations and the Subdivision Map Act, (ii) design review, use permit, temporary use permit, planned development, zoning amendment, waiver, variance, general plan amendment, development agreement, or any other discretionary approval from the City of San Carlos necessary for the development of a site within the Northeast Area in accordance with the San Carlos Zoning Ordinance, or (iii) a building permit required for construction and/or alterations on property within the Northeast Area in accordance with the San Carlos Municipal Code.

Current exceptions to the moratorium include (i) development applications that have been approved or deemed complete prior to the adoption of the Interim Ordinance, (ii) building permits for the construction of tenant improvements to space within an existing building occupied by uses permitted within the applicable zoning district under the San Carlos Zoning Ordinance, and (iii) a change of use within space of an existing building and any associated tenant improvements, provided the new use is permitted as of right pursuant to the applicable zoning district under the San Carlos Zoning Ordinance.

For purposes of the interim ordinance, the Northeast Area that is the subject of this public hearing is all land or sites within the area depicted in the map set forth below.



On April 25, 2022, the City Council adopted an Interim Ordinance to establish a development moratorium for the Northeast Area. During the City Council meeting on May 23, 2022, the City Council will consider extending the development moratorium for an additional 22 months and 15 days (for a total of two years), as well as possible modifications to the scope of the Interim Ordinance. The extension of this interim ordinance is not a project subject to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") because the interim ordinance will not result in a direct physical change in the environment nor a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Further, even assuming the interim ordinance is a project as defined in CEQA, the interim ordinance is exempt from environmental review pursuant to section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines because it is covered by the common sense exemption that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment and where, as in the case of the interim ordinance, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption of the interim ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment, the adoption of the interim ordinance is not subject to CEQA.
