WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital is a 700-bed skilled nursing and rehabilitation facility run by the Department of Public Health (DPH), one of the largest skilled nursing facilities in the United States of America offering restorative services for medical, mental and behavioral health issues such as drug addiction, dementia and long-term illness to mostly low-income and otherwise vulnerable residents; and

WHEREAS, On April 14, 2022, the federal government gave DPH notice of its intent to freeze critical Medicare and Medicaid funding to Laguna Honda Hospital, which constitutes two-thirds of the funding that the facility receives, after missing a federally-imposed 6-month deadline to meet the standards required by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and address a list of health and safety violations, including issues with infection prevention and control, hand hygiene and medical documentation; and

WHEREAS, Despite improvements to comply with regulators, CMS terminated Laguna Honda's participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs and its certification; and

WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital will continue to remain open and licensed, but is undergoing a process to achieve recertification; and

WHEREAS, While Laguna Honda Hospital works towards recertification, CMS requires the concurrent submission of a Closure and Transfer plan to continue funding to care for patients; and

WHEREAS, On May 13, 2022, Laguna Honda Hospital submitted a Closure and Patient Transfer and Relocation Plan to the CMS, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) stating September 13, 2022 as the official closure date of the facility, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 220618, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On May 15, 2022, patients of Laguna Honda Hospital received notices that they may be relocated to other stable supportive housing or skilled nursing facilities, as a result of the closure and transfer plan; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco convene as a Committee of the Whole on Tuesday, June 14, 2022, at 3:00 p.m., to hold a public hearing requesting the Department of Public Health to present on Laguna Honda Hospital's strategy for recertification and the submission of the Closure and Patient Transfer and Relocation Plan for Laguna Honda Hospital.
