Motion that the Board of Supervisors convene in closed session on June 7, 2022, pursuant to California Government Code, Section 54956.9, and San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 67.10(d)(2), for the purpose of conferring with, or receiving advice from, the City Attorney regarding anticipated litigation in which the City may be a plaintiff or defendant, regarding existing and possible future claims and demands submitted for damage to real and personal property by hotels that have operated as Shelter-in-Place Hotels during the COVID-19 pandemic, including: F Good LLC (AKA Good Hotel), SF Vertigo LLC (AKA Hotel Vertigo), SF 100-120 Powell Owner L.P. (AKA Hotel Union Square), and 345 Taylor Owner LLC (AKA Tilden Hotel).

WHEREAS, California Government Code, Section 54956.9 and San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 67.10(d)(2) allow the Board of Supervisors to convene in closed session to confer with or receive advice from legal counsel regarding anticipated litigation; and

WHEREAS, Beginning in March 2020, the City procured hotel rooms to allow people who had contracted or been exposed to COVID-19 to isolate and guarantine, and to allow people experiencing homelessness to safely shelter in place; and

WHEREAS, In total, the City entered into booking contracts with 29 hotels, 14 of which are still leased and occupied by the City; and

WHEREAS. Several of the hotels that provided rooms pursuant to these contracts now allege that the City's occupancy resulted in significant damage to real and personal property, and have filed claims or made demands against the City for compensation for the alleged damage; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors convene in closed session on June 7, 2022, with the City Attorney's Office for the purpose of conferring with, or receiving advice from, the City Attorney regarding this anticipated litigation.
