3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Jonathan Tuse and Sarah
4	Falconer against the City and County of San Francisco for \$525,000; the lawsuit was
5	filed on March 23, 2020, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-583895;
6	entitled Jonathan Tuse, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.; the lawsuit
7	alleged a personal injury in Huntington Park resulting from a falling tree branch.
