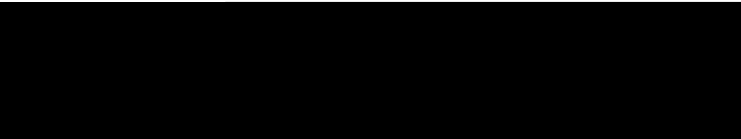

I believe that San Francisco must hold on to it's children and families. I came to the city when I was 11, right after the Robert Kennedy assassination and San Francisco was like Oz. From the Palace of Fine Arts to the Cliff House, everything said WELCOME. My favorite spot was the Academy of Sciences and even though I love the new buidling I miss that whale sculpture!

Business and/or Professional Experience:

I work with and represent a diverse and dedicated group of family child care providers from every district. It is our mission to provide the best quality care for young children which requires that not only are we well educated, but that we recognize the value of and need for early educators that are not just culturally respectful, but that represent the cultures and speak the languages of the children and families they serve.

Children have so much to learn and adults are anxious to cram content into their heads but they often forget that childhood is important, not just for the learning, but for the experiences, adventures, discoveries and silly play that is essential for them to grow up to be people who can feel and express fun, awe and joy.

I teach pre service teachers at CCSF and SFSU and it is my goal that all of us remember that our first commitment to children is to respect them and keep them from harm.

Civic Activities:

I work with family childcare providers who have been providing care for decades and are looking for new and better ways to support young children as they transition to kindergarten.

I work with new family childcare providers and help them navigate the often confusing and conflicting paths to entrepreneurship and public service.

I work with immigrant family childcare providers for whom English is not their first language and provide them with supports that affirm the value of bilingualism and dual language learning so that no child or family feels they must abandon their native language while they learn English.

I work with Black parents who are struggling to stay in a city that has for decades pushed them out and together we search for solutions to low income, poor quality childcare, better academic outcomes and belonging in a city that needs them to stay.
