Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

- (a) The San Francisco District Attorney ("District Attorney") was awarded \$1,350,000 by the State of California Board of State and Community Corrections to support the County Resentencing Pilot Program, and was notified of the distribution of funds via e-mail in August 2021 but did not receive the Notice of Award letter and checks until November 2021.
- (b) The County Resentencing Pilot Program was established via the State Budget trailer bill <u>SB 145</u>.

- (c) The program period is from September 1, 2021 to September 1, 2024, with the final report due to the California State Legislature from an evaluator by January 31, 2025
 - (d) The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs.

Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

- (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, State of California Board of State and Community Corrections grant funds in the amount of \$1,350,000 to support the County Resentencing Pilot Program's two-fold goal: 1) ensure that the District Attorney in each county has the resources needed to exercise their discretion under Penal Code 1170(d)(1); and 2) evaluate a collaborative approach to exercising prosecutorial resentencing discretion.
- (b) The District Attorney proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget, and indirect costs are hereby waived.
- (c) The total personnel budget for the two (2) new positions (2.0 FTE) is \$1,100,000 of the total grant award of \$1,350,000 for the term September 1, 2021 to September 1, 2024. The balance of the grant award is allocated to pay for \$250,000 in contractual services with a community-based organization.
 - (d) Any interest earned on the grant funds must go to the funded activities.

Section 3. Grant funded positions: Amendment to Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Annual Salary Ordinance.
